

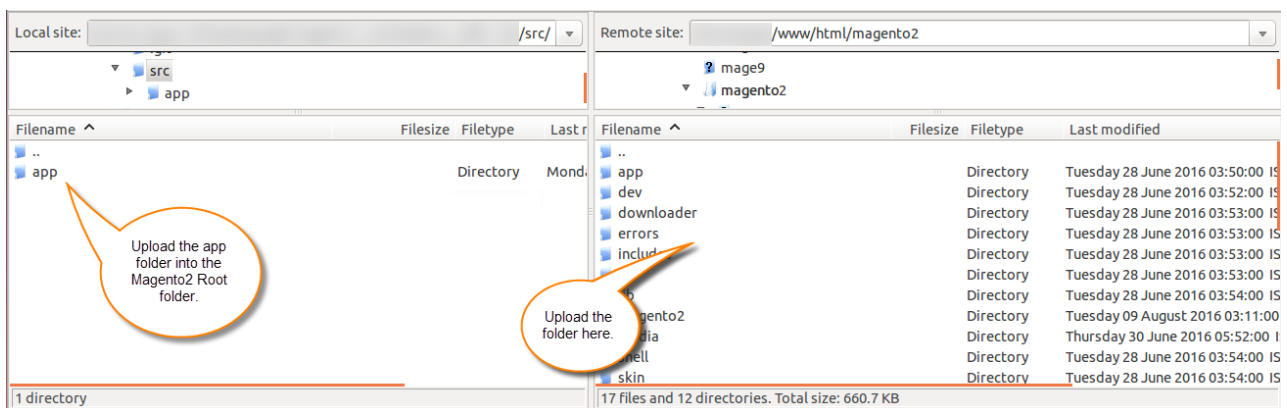
# Daily Deals v3.0.1

---

## Installation

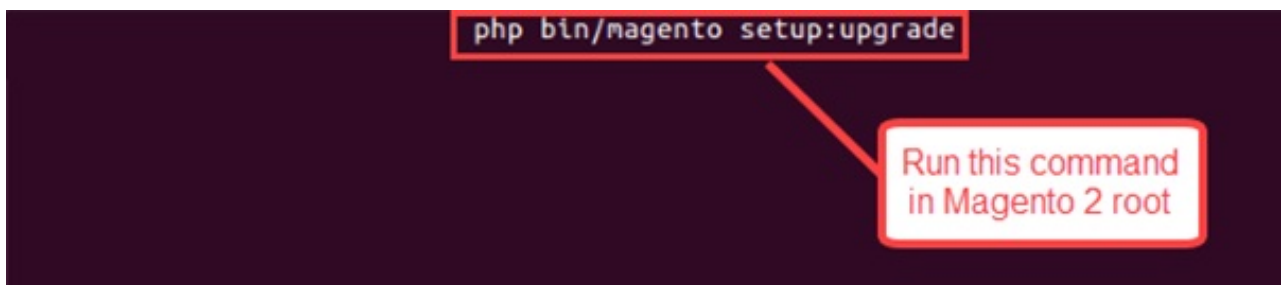
Customers will get a **zip folder** and they have to extract the contents of this zip folder on their system. The extracted folder has an **src** folder, inside the src folder you have the **app** folder.

You need to transfer this app folder into the Magento 2 root directory on the server as shown below.

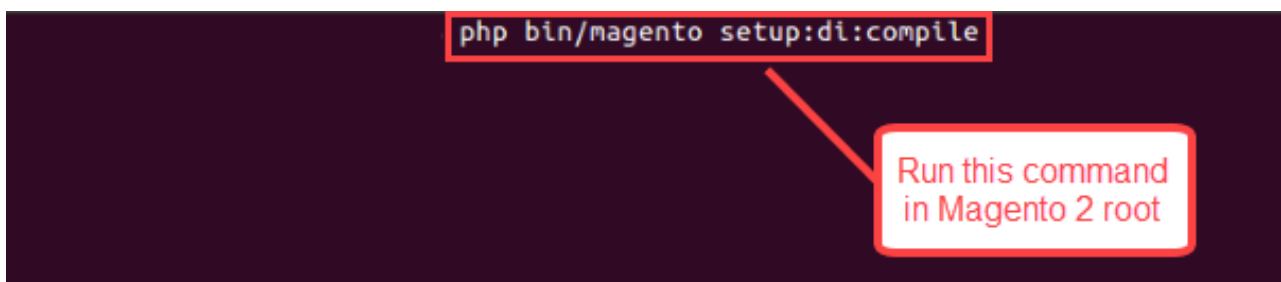


After the successful installation, you have to run these commands in the Magento2 root directory.

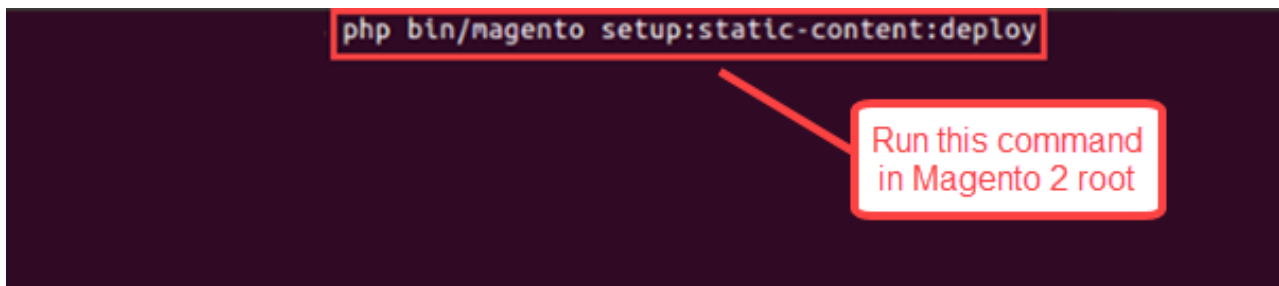
**First command- `php bin/magento setup:upgrade`**



**Second Command - `php bin/magento setup:di:compile`**



**Third Command - `php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy`**



After running the commands, you have to flush the cache from the Magento admin panel by navigating through->**System->Cache management** as shown below.

For Multilingual support, please navigate to **Store>Configuration>General >Locale Options**. And select your desired language from the **Locale** option.

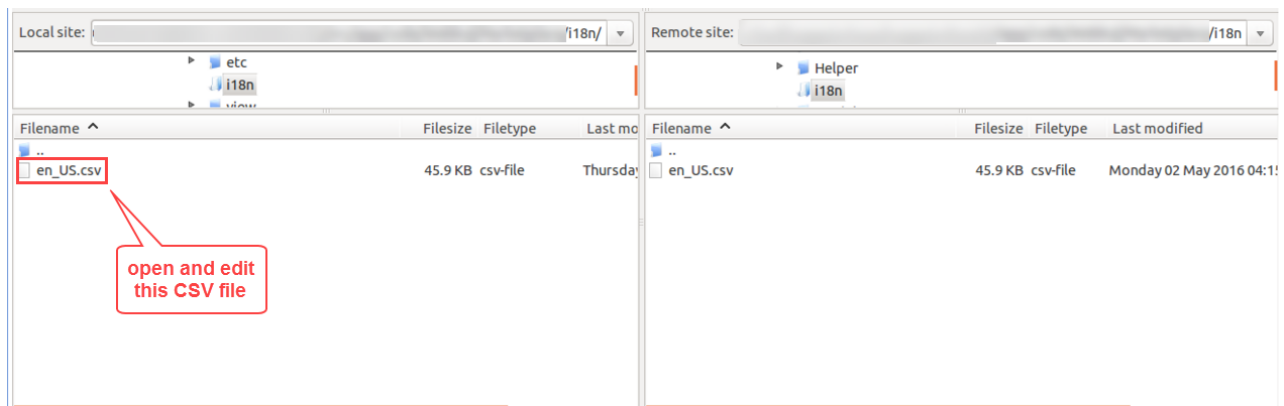

Open the file named **en\_US.CSV** for editing as shown in the below screenshot.

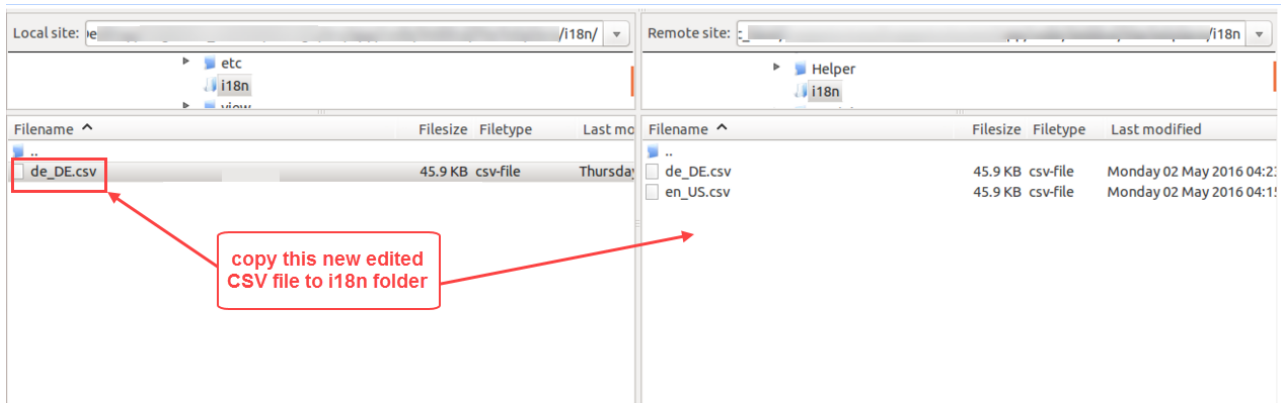


Once you have opened the file for editing. Replace the words after the **comma(,)** on the right with your translated words.

After editing and translating the CSV file, you need to save the translated file name according to your region language and country code such as – **de\_DE.CSV**.

Then upload the translated file to the same folder from where you have obtained it. Now your module translation is complete.



## How to enable the module via terminal?

For enabling the module via terminal, the admin needs to run the following commands:

### First Command –

```
php bin/magento module:enable Webkul_DailyDeals
```

### Second Command –

```
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

### Third Command –

```
php bin/magento setup:di:compile
```

### Forth Command –

```
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
```

## How to disable the module?

If the admin wants to disable the module completely, then they need to run the following command through terminal:

### First Command –

```
php bin/magento dailydeal:disable
```

### Second Command –

```
php bin/magento setup:di:compile
```

### Third Command –

```
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
```
