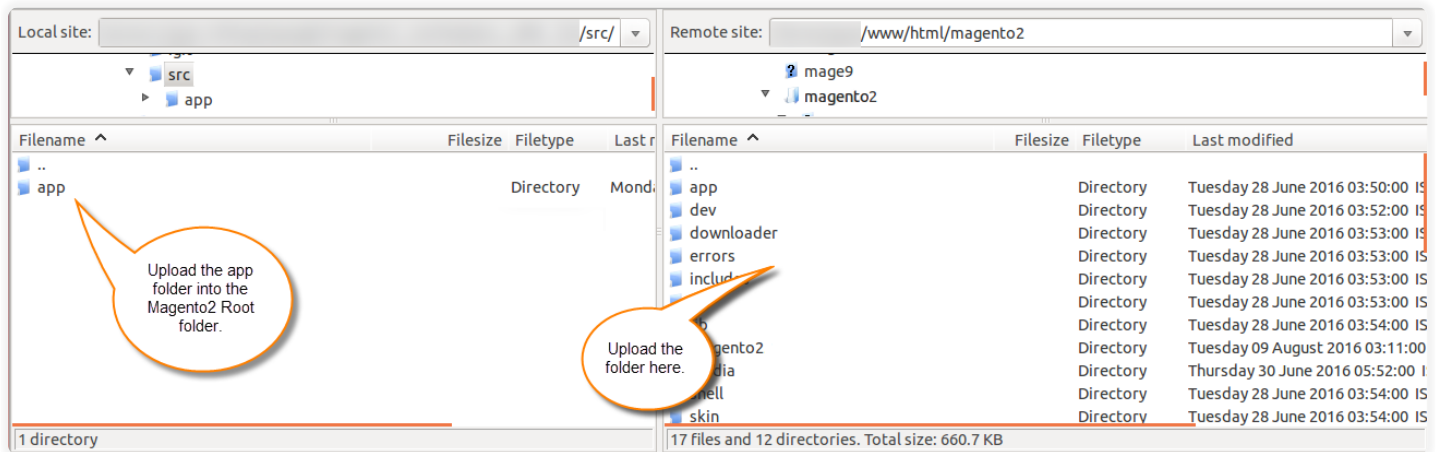


Advanced Commission Marketplace Add-On V5.0.0

Installation

Customers will get a **zip folder** and they have to extract the contents of this zip folder on their system. The extracted folder has an **src** folder, inside the src folder you have the **app** folder.

You need to transfer this **app** folder into the Magento2 root directory on the server as shown below.



After the successful installation, you have to **run these commands** in the **Magento2 root** directory:

First command –

```
1 php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

Second Command –

1 php bin/magento setup:di:compile

Third Command –

1 php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy

After running the commands, you have to flush the cache from the Magento admin panel by navigating through->**System->Cache management** as shown below:

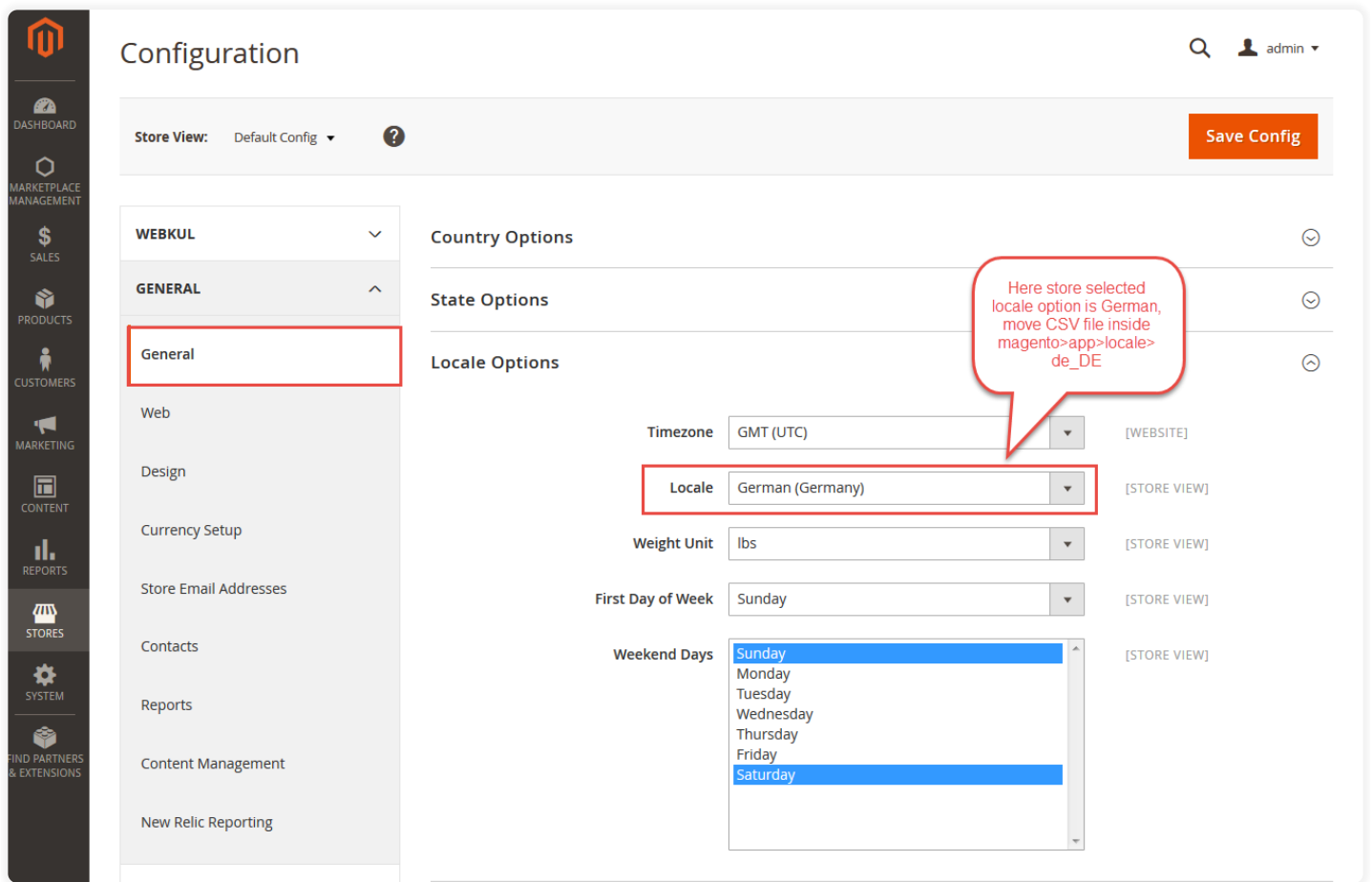

Thus, in this way, the module has been installed.

Multi-Lingual Support

For the **multilingual** support, the admin will navigate through **Store->Configuration->General ->Locale Options**.

After that, select the **locale** as German (the language into which admin wants to translate his store content).



Language Translation

If the user wants to translate their module from English to German then they need to follow the path:

app/code/Webkul/MpAdvancedCommission/i18n in their unzipped Magento Marketplace folder and will get a CSV file with name “en_US.csv”.

Now, they will rename that csv as “de_DE.csv” and translate all right side content after the comma in the German language.

After editing the CSV, save it and then upload it to the path

app/code/Webkul/MpAdvancedCommission/i18n where they have installed Magento 2.

The module will get translated in the German Language. It supports both the **LTR** and **RTL** languages.
