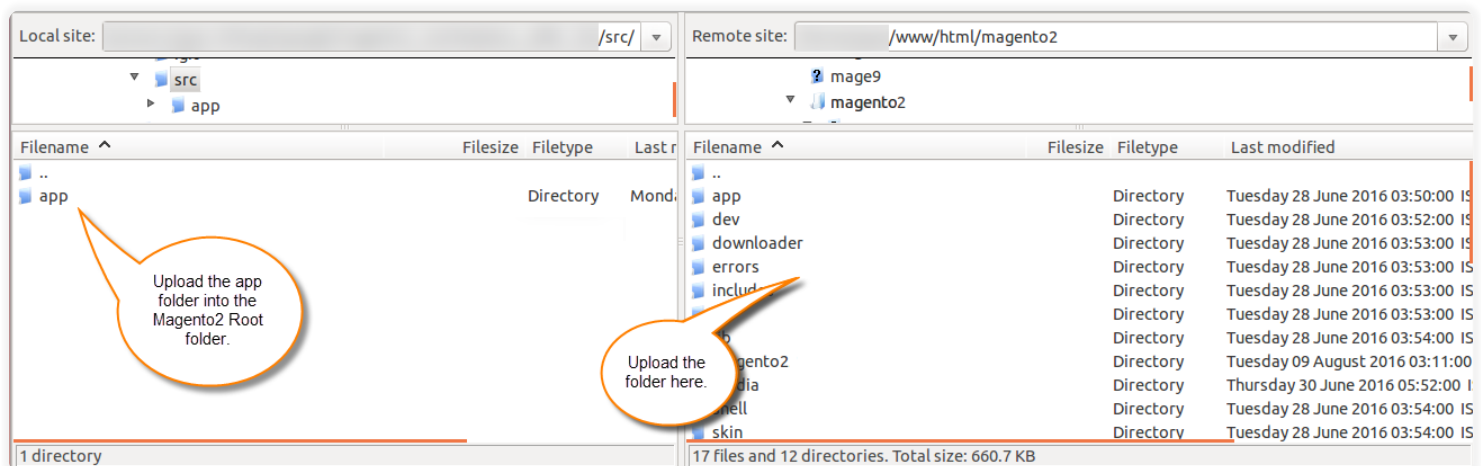


Installation Of Per Country Shipping Marketplace Add-On

Customers will get a **zip folder** and they have to extract the contents of this zip folder on their system. The extracted folder has a **src** folder, inside the src folder you have the **app** folder.

You need to transfer this **app** folder into the Magento2 root directory on the server as shown below in the screenshot.



After the successful installation, you have to **run these commands** in the **Magento2 root** directory:

First command –

```
1 php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

Second Command –

1 php bin/magento setup:di:compile

Third Command –

1 php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy

Cache Management

After running the commands, you have to flush the cache from the Magento admin panel. Navigating through =>**System** =>**Cache management** as shown below:

Configuration Of Multi-Lingual Support

For the **multilingual** support, the admin needs to navigate through **Store** => **Configuration** => **General** => **Locale Options**. And then select the **locale** as German (the language into which admin wants to translate his store content).


Translation

If a user wants to translate their module from English to German then follow the path. Path to follow – **app/code/Webkul/Mppercountryperproductshipping/i18n** in their unzipped Magento Marketplace folder.

The user will get a CSV file with name “en_US.csv”. Forthwith they will rename that CSV as “de_DE.csv” furthermore translates all right side content after the comma in the German language.

After editing the CSV, save it and then upload it. Follow the path **app/code/Webkul/Mppercountryperproductshipping/i18n** where they have installed Magento2 on their server.

The module will get translated in the German Language. It supports both the **LTR** and **RTL** languages.
