## Setup step 1 - Installation: Download and unpack the module

- The module is in Marketplace format. Therefore, you need to do the following to install it:
- Go to your project root and execute the following:
- `mkdir -p app/code/Wizkunde/ConfigurableBundle`
- `cd app/code/Wizkunde/ConfigurableBundle`
- `unzip [your directory]/ConfigurableBundle.zip`

## Setup step 2: Install the module

Run: `bin/magento setup:upgrade`

### Additional Configuration Settings

If you go to Stores -> Configuration -> Wizkunde Configuration, you will notice a section with extra configuration options, to further change the way a bundle product is displayed in your shop. Evaluate these options closely and see if it suits your shop layout style.

- Remove the Customize and Add to Cart button - Will remove the Customize and Add to Cart button, and immediately unfold the bundle options to make them visible
- Move options to the top right - This will move the options to the top right of the screen, so that it looks more like a configurable product
- Show selection image on preselected single selection - Choose to display the image underneath the option
- Show selected short description under the selection label - Display the selected option short description or omit it.
