


OPTIMONK EXTENSION FOR MAGENTO 2.X

You can install the OptiMonk extension for Magento 2.x through the Web Setup Wizard on the Admin of your Magento store. For more information on how to install extensions, please refer to the Magento User Guide:

After the installation process is complete, all you need to do is to fill in your OptiMonk User ID and activate the extension.

1. If you are not already logged in, log in to the Admin of your Magento store as a user with full administrator rights.
2. On the Admin sidebar, click Stores, then under Settings, tap Configuration.



3. Look up OptiMonk in the menu on the left side of the screen, and open the settings. Enable the extension using the drop-down menu.



4. After enabling the extension, the User ID input will appear. Copy your OptiMonk *Account ID* into this field. You can find your *Account ID* at the bottom of the main page in your OptiMonk dashboard. Open a new browser window and login to your OptiMonk dashboard. Scroll down to the bottom and click on the Magento tab below ‘Start using OptiMonk on your website’. You’ll see your *Account ID* listed in bold. Copy or make note of this number. Return to the OptiMonk extension settings page in your Magento Admin, and paste it in the *Account ID* field.
